Guest Speaker – Sierra Faust of Art and Frame Warehouse

Sierra talked about how to present in a gallery:

Use a frame suitable for piece. A simple black or white frame is a good choice. Do not make mat too small – no smaller than 2.5 to 3 inches is a good size. Whites and off-whites are standard. A very large photograph is OK without a mat. Linen mats can make piece more formal. Mats must be acid free. The correct backing is important – acid free. Almost anything can be framed, even heavy items. Frames can also be hinged. Pedestal boxes are also available. You can have a plexiglass box.
