Also on Saturday morning, we're hosting the annual Kids Fishing Derby at The Lake from 9:00 am to 10:30 am, where kids up to age 12 will be fishing in The Lake on the Crestview property. We'd love to have artists set up all along the lake! What a fun setting for your Quick Paint!

ELIGIBILITY

Participation in this Plein Air QUICK PAINT event is open to all registered artists, age 18 or older. Registration is required. ***You must also be registered in the MAIN EVENT to be eligible for the Quick Paint.*** Main Event registration is separate.

CHECK IN AND STAMPING

Saturday, June 17, 2023 – 7:00 am to 8:00 am

Quick Paint begins promptly at 8:00 am and ends at exactly 10:00 am. All materials **MUST** be stamped with the Quick Paint stamp prior to starting work.

PAINTING LOCATION – Crestview Dairy ONLY

Artwork materials **MUST** be stamped with “Quick Paint” stamp prior to starting work to ensure that the submitted work has been created during the event. Artists may spread out all over the 31 acres of Crestview Dairy property to paint.

ARTWORK TURN IN

**All Quick Paint artworks must have the Quick Paint Stamp to be eligible for judging. All artworks must be completed, framed, and turned in for judging no later than 10:30 am. All artworks must be created between 8:00 am and 10:00 am on Saturday only.*

MATERIALS

Artists may only submit ONE piece for the Quick Paint judging. Submitted pieces may be small or large.

- SMALL pieces: maximum material size is 12 inches X 12 inches of canvas, paper or board, unframed.
- LARGE pieces: maximum material size is 320 square inches of canvas, paper or board, unframed.
- FORMULA: sq. inches = length X width

Examples: 16” X 20” = 320 sq. inches; 14” X 22” = 308 sq. inches

Frame width: maximum 4 1/3 inches. Mat width: maximum 4 inches (watercolors, etc.)

Media may include: oils, acrylics, watercolors, pastels, gouache, inks and/or pencils.

For dark-colored materials, please paint a white patch to provide a legible stamping area.

GUIDELINES

All Quick Paint artworks must be created on-site, at Crestview Dairy only, within the event venue boundaries, in the true spirit of plein air. All Quick Paint artwork will be on exhibition for sale until Saturday at 7:00 pm.

PRICING

- All artworks will be sold at prices selected by the artist.
- Price changes will not be allowed after artwork submission. Any manual price changes found on the title cards will result in the removal of the corresponding painting from the exhibition.
- All submitted artwork must be for sale.

COMMISSION

Summit Art will retain a 25% commission on all artwork sales. Artist payments will be mailed within 30 days of the end of the event to the address provided at registration.

ARTIST AWARDS JUDGING

Judging for the Quick Paint artworks will take place at 10:30 am on Saturday, June 17, 2023, at the exhibition tent by the Dairy Barn.

CASH PRIZE

\$200 – to be awarded during Saturday’s Artist Awards Presentation. Quick Paint award winner must be present at the presentation in order to receive award. Artist Awards Presentation is Saturday, June 17, 2023, beginning at 4:00 pm.

ARTWORK PICKUP

Following the awards presentation, at the artist’s discretion, all plein air art will be displayed for sale in the Exhibition Tent at Crestview Dairy until 7:00 pm on Saturday, June 17, 2023. All unsold artworks must be picked up by the artist or a designated agent no later than 7:00 pm on Saturday, June 17, 2023. Any other pick-up arrangements must be approved by Summit Art festival management.

LIABILITY

Regardless of cause, the artist agrees to bear all risk and expense for any loss, theft and/or damage to their artwork or other personal property or injury to their person. The artist agrees to be responsible for insuring their artwork, if so desired.
