A great event for plein air painters and spectators! A Paint Out is a “Quick Paint” competition - an exciting competition for plein air painters working on location. Artists will compete for TWO \$250 Purchase Awards sponsored by Summit Art.

This Paint Out happens during Missouri Town’s annual Fall Festival of Arts, Crafts and Music. Attendance is expected to be about 8,000 people! Historic interpreters, artisans, musicians, dancers and crafters will bring to life the celebration that took place as the crops came in. Hitch a ride on a wagon, see sorghum being made, play a 19th century game and make memories to last a lifetime. ***As you can see, there will be MANY amazing features to paint!***

Purchase Award RAFFLES: We will be selling \$5.00 (or 3 for \$10) raffle tickets for the Purchase Awards. The winning ticket for Quick Paint #1 will be drawn at noon. The winning ticket for Quick Paint #2 will be drawn at 4pm. The winner of the raffle ticket drawing will select the painting for the Purchase Award, and they get to take it home! The selected artist will receive \$250 from Summit Art. Any proceeds beyond \$250 will benefit Summit Art. ABOUT MISSOURI TOWN LIVING HISTORY MUSEUM

Experience the sights, sounds, and smells of a small Missouri town on the eve of the Civil War. Missouri Town is a living history museum with more than 25 buildings dating from 1822 – 1860 spread across nearly 30 picturesque acres. Original structures from seven western Missouri counties are filled with historic tools and furnishings, setting the stage for life in the mid-1800s.

During self-guided tours, living history interpreters, heirloom crops, and heritage breed livestock will tell the story of daily life in the small 19th century towns of this region. The museum is situated on rolling, grassy land, with a gravel lane through the center of the site. Please traverse with care. For the safety of our livestock and interpreters, pets are not permitted in the village.



There is an admission fee per vehicle for the public:
\$15 per car; \$25 per bus

livestock and crops!

Award and Competition Rules

Who may participate: Artists who have pre-registered online and paid the \$25 registration fee to Summit Art. Artists register here: summitart.org

Painting time: 3 hours for each Quick Paint

Artwork specifications:

- Canvas must be stamped at check-in.
- Pieces must be framed and wired for hanging. Gallery-wrapped canvas does not have to be framed.
- Maximum number of pieces eligible for awards: TWO per artist for each Quick Paint
- Artists may also hang as many other pieces as they can finish for the Art Show & Sale.
- Maximum size: 24" on the longest side.
- All painting media are welcome.
- Paintings must begin on a blank white or toned background.
- Artwork must be signed.
- Work must be created solely by the artist and done completely from life during the competition.
- Work must be turned in no later than noon for Quick Paint #1 and no later than 4:00 pm for Quick Paint #2 and remain on display until the conclusion of the event at 5:00 pm.
- The paintings selected for the Purchase Awards become the property of the purchaser of the winning raffle ticket.
- Pick up: unsold works must be picked up on-site, immediately following the event. Abandoned artwork will become property of Summit Art.

Sale event: The award presentation and Art Show & Sale will occur immediately following the painting competitions. This event is open to the public.

Sales:

- Artists set the prices. Summit Art will retain a 25% commission as a fee for service.
- Summit Art staff will process sales; checks will be mailed to artists within one month after the event.
- Prices are non-negotiable.

Awards: Two Purchase Awards of \$250 each will be awarded to the artist selected by the holder of the winning raffle ticket.
